Dr. Tommaso Lupattelli is one of **Italy's leading experts in embolization procedures**, minimally invasive treatments designed to block blood flow to specific areas of the body. These procedures effectively address a wide range of conditions in both men and women. **With over 3,500 successful cases, his expertise spans treatments for female conditions such as uterine fibroid and adenomyosis embolization, as well as male-specific conditions like varicocele embolization, prostate adenoma embolization, and hemorrhoid embolization.** He also specializes in treating venous and arteriovenous malformations.

Internationally, Dr. Lupattelli is renowned for having the **largest documented case history of angioplasty (PTA) procedures for Chronic Cerebrospinal Venous Insufficiency (CCSVI)**, a condition often linked to multiple sclerosis, Meniere's disease, and chronic drug-resistant headaches.

Dr. Lupattelli practices at GVM healthcare facilities in Rome and Bologna, where he has served as the Medical Director of Interventional Radiology. He also collaborates with other prestigious medical centers in Milan.

EDUCATION

Dr. Tommaso Lupattelli has followed a distinguished training path, establishing himself as one of the leading experts in interventional radiology and vascular surgery. He graduated with honors (110 cum laude) in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Perugia, Italy, in 1999 and later specialized in Radiology at the same institution, **presenting an innovative thesis on arterial embolization for the treatment of symptomatic fibroids.** He further advanced his expertise by completing a specialization in Vascular Surgery at the University of Milan, focusing on advanced endovascular techniques for diabetic foot revascularization.

Dr. Lupattelli's international training includes fellowships at renowned university hospitals in London, such as the Royal Free Hospital, Imperial College (Hammersmith), and St. George's Hospital, where he refined his skills in **advanced interventional radiology techniques**. In 2011, he earned a Master's Degree from the University of Ferrara in the Department of Vascular Diseases, specializing in Hemodynamics and Advanced Venous Surgery. For many years, he worked together with Dr. Jacques Clerissi, the pioneer of embolization for treating uterine fibroids.

PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY

Dr. Tommaso Lupattelli has gained extensive professional experience as a Medical Director in Interventional Radiology at some of Italy's most prestigious hospitals, including Villa Torri in Bologna, Salus Hospital in Reggio Emilia, Clinica Città di Pavia, and Multimedica Hospital in Milan. Since 2012, he has served as the Director of the Interventional Radiology Unit at ICC GVM Sanità in Rome.

Beyond his clinical work, Dr. Lupattelli has contributed to academia as a lecturer in Radiology and Interventional Radiology at the University of Perugia. He has also organized and led numerous training courses in Italy and internationally, including in Lebanon and Mexico, focusing on advanced techniques such as diabetic foot revascularization and uterine fibroid embolization. His career reflects an unwavering commitment to advancing and sharing the latest innovations in interventional radiology.

Dr. Tommaso Lupattelli is the author of over 200 scientific publications, including approximately 50 articles in academic journals, focusing on **pioneering techniques that have become standard in interventional radiology and the treatment of arteriovenous malformations**. Among his significant contributions is research on the application of Onyx, a liquid embolic agent, for the management of peripheral hemorrhages.

Dr. Lupattelli serves as an Editor for the American Journal of Angiology and Vascular Surgery and acts as a peer reviewer for several leading scientific journals in the field of interventional radiology. He has also contributed to scientific textbooks and supervised the Italian editions of several English-language books and manuals.

His innovative work and contributions have earned widespread recognition, with features in prominent national and international publications, including *Forbes*, *Sole24Ore*, *Il Messaggero*, and *World Excellence*.
